

Where to start

You do not need all 45 cards to govern one agent. The toolkit is modular: take the path that matches your situation, and open the other cards only on the day the question arises. Four paths start from a situation, two run a whole family.

I am launching my first agent

You are starting from nothing. The point is not to cover everything, it is to delegate nothing you have not written down.

I am preparing my organisation

No agent is live yet, or several already are without anyone having decided so.

I am governing a fleet

The first agent is governed by attention. The tenth is governed by inventory, or it is not governed at all.

10 CARDS · THE ORGANISE FAMILY

I am bringing my organisation up to speed

The agent is never alone: it shifts roles, skills and power. This family runs end to end, in order.

15 CARDS · THE OPERATE FAMILY

I am running the agent day to day

From the setting to the proof. This family runs end to end, in the order of an agent's life, from configuration to leaving the vendor.
