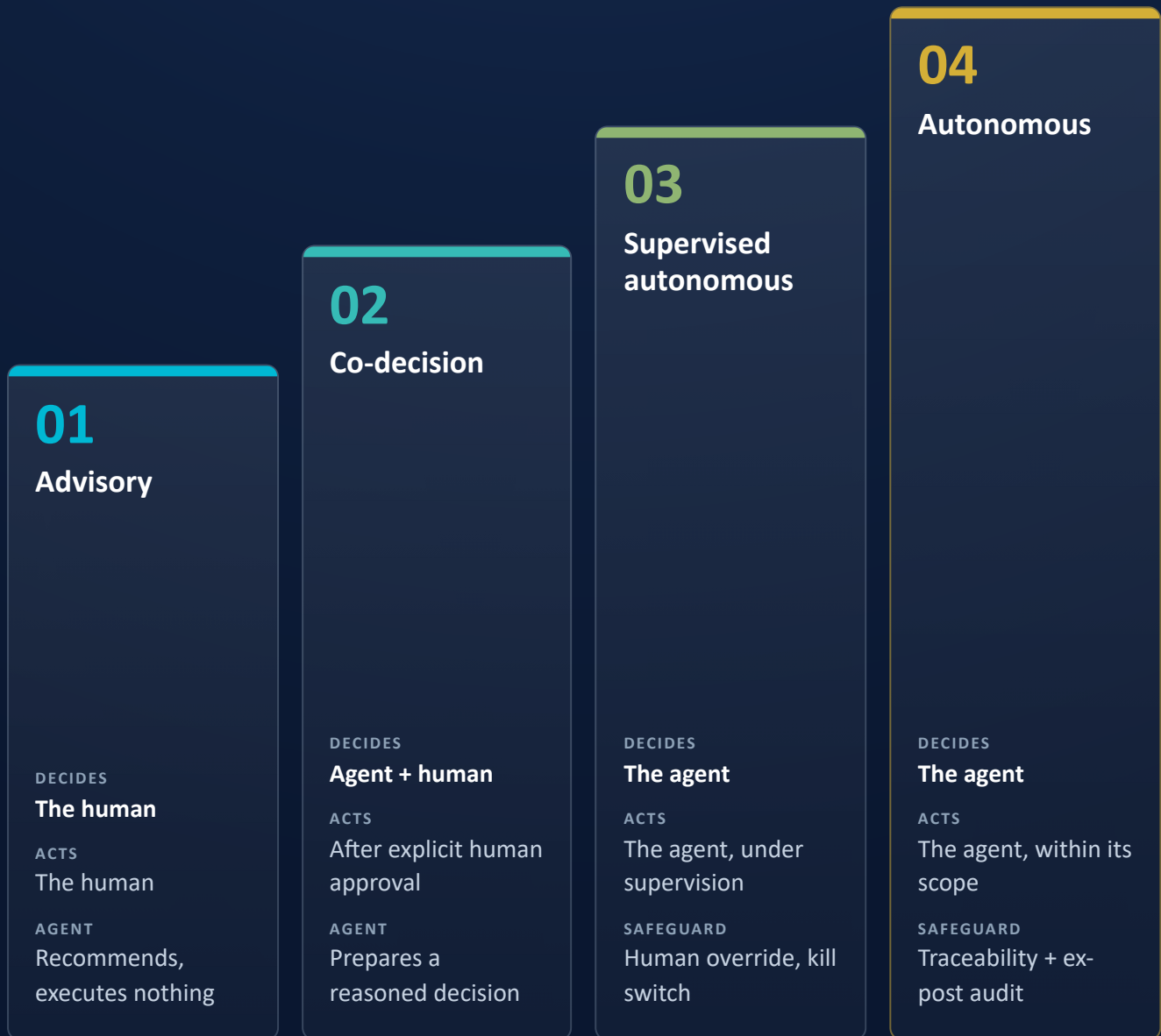


The 4 levels of delegated autonomy

Delegation is not all or nothing. For **each type of decision**, ACF defines an autonomy level : from a simple suggestion to autonomous action. The higher you go, the more the agent decides on its own; the tighter upstream governance must be.

The authorized level is not a matter of comfort: it **derives from the criticality score**. The more critical a decision (**irreversible, high-impact**), the lower the permitted autonomy level : until it reverts entirely to the human beyond the threshold.
