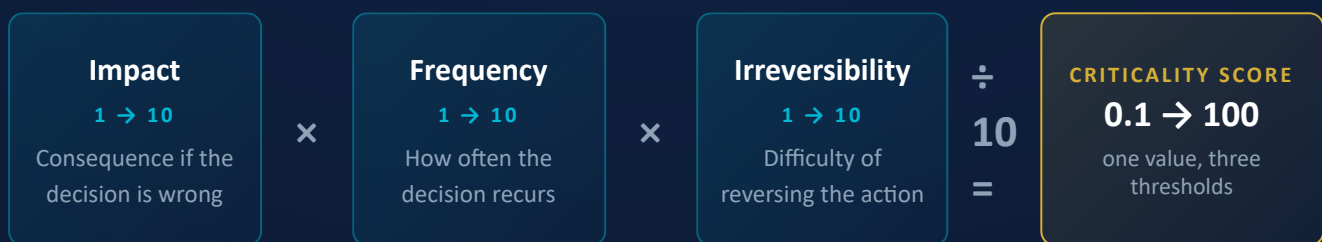
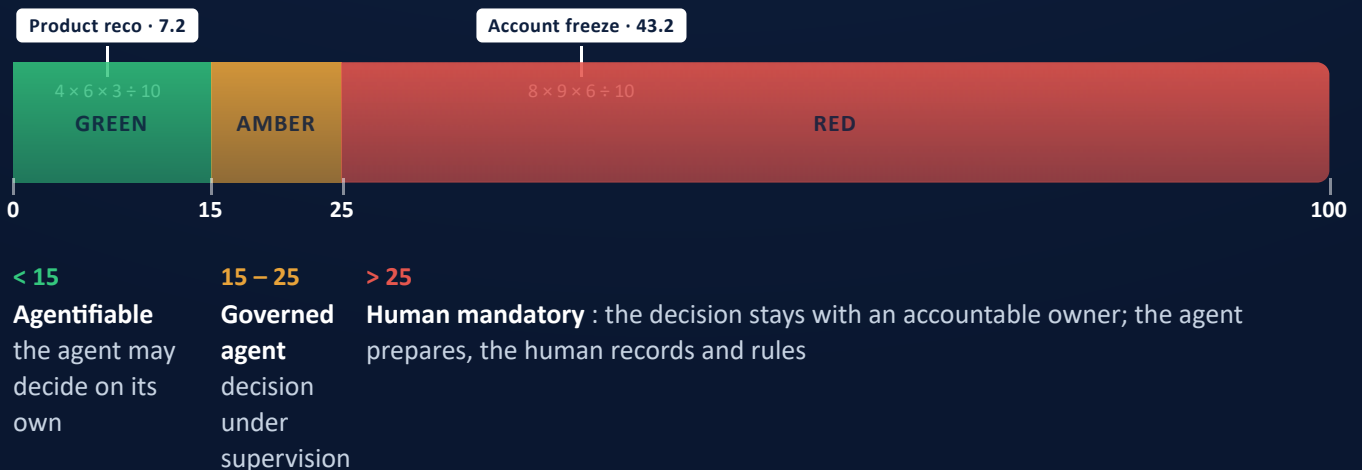


Measuring the **criticality** of a decision

Before delegating a decision to an agent, ACF measures it across three axes · **impact**, **frequency**, **irreversibility** : each scored from 1 to 10. The product, divided by 10, yields a **criticality score** that determines the governance regime.



THE SCORE POSITIONS THE DECISION ON THE ACF SCALE



The threshold is not an "extra" risk rating: it is a **governance routing rule**. Two decisions with identical impact may end up in two different regimes if one is **reversible** and the other is not. Irreversibility is what drives the score up, and what brings the human back into the loop.
