

# The 4 levels of agentic maturity

Where the 4 autonomy levels qualify **a single decision**, maturity qualifies **an agent as a whole**: how far has the organization handed over the wheel? ACF distinguishes four tiers, from mute automation to supervised autonomy.

Do not conflate the two scales: **maturity** (N0→N3) describes where **an agent stands overall**; the **4 autonomy levels** (Suggestive → Autonomous) describe what it is allowed to do **decision by decision**. An N2 agent may remain "Suggestive" on critical decisions.
