

Deploying ACF in 6 steps

ACF is not a one-time checklist. It is a **cycle**: diagnose, map, frame, deploy, supervise, audit, then start over. Here is the order of operations, and the toolkit cards that equip each step.

Diagnose

Measure your exposure and digital dependency before any delegation. The mandatory starting point.
