The toolkit provides the instruments. Three separate collections say what they are for, each in its own way. **None of the three is part of the 45 cards:** each is published and downloaded separately.

End-to-end cases, one per sector, built for projection rather than demonstration. Health, public administration, banking, insurance, industry, transport, energy, telecoms, retail. Each handbook follows the same path, from the initial situation to leaving the vendor, naming at every step the cards it uses. **The framework does not move, the context does:** exactly what one expects from a standard. The organisations described are fictional and built for learning.

Eighteen real companies and schemes, analysed with the ACF grid **from public information and nothing else:** Morgan Stanley, Klarna, Air Canada, Cruise, Waymo, Workday, Replit, Cursor, DPD, Perplexity, among others. Nine teaching kits accompany the publications, each setting a reference case against an incident. The analysis never claims to know these organisations' internal arrangements.

ACF MCP

"The framework answers inside the tool."

The standard's official Model Context Protocol server, published on npm as **acf-mcp**. It exposes the doctrine, the cards, the glossary and the regulatory mappings to any compatible assistant, Claude Desktop, Cursor, Windsurf. Twelve tools, seven of which return a structured qualification from a case: autonomy level, criticality, obligations by lifecycle phase, DDAO controls. **None of them calls a model:** the answer comes from a versioned knowledge base, and every output carries the version and the fingerprint of the doctrine that produced it. It stands as preliminary qualification, never legal advice, and always calls for human review.
